

Kindness Capstone Project Presentation • Days 1-4

During this final week of class, each team will work together to create a presentation for their Kindness Capstone Project. This can be a slide show, video, speech, tri-board, etc. Every person on the team must participate in the presentation in some fashion.

Weekly Objectives

Students will:

- Use creativity and knowledge to design a project presentation that shares their Kindness Capstone Project and motivates others to join them or create their own
- Present the project in class.

Resources / Materials

- Paper and pencils
- Project Presentation Proposal
- Project Presentation Rubric
- Basic Art Supplies
- Computer with Internet (depends on project proposals)

Deliverables:

- Team Meeting with Teacher
- Daily Participation points

Reminder: participation points are doubled on class workdays

Discussion Starter:

- What do you want your Kindness Capstone Project to be remembered for?
- If you could do it all over again, would you focus on a different kindness asset in our community? Why or why not?
- Did any hidden kindness assets present themselves as you got to know your community on a more personal level? If so, why do you think that occurred?



Inspire

The structure of this week is heavily focused on time in class to finish your final group project presentation. Given that each group is different in its skill sets and talents, each group may choose their project format, similar in fashion to how we chose our self-reflections. Each group must submit a Presentation Proposal by the end of the class period today. You will then have 3 class periods to work on and perfect your presentation before we present them on the final day of class. Each team will have a maximum of 7 minutes for their presentation with 3 minutes for questions and answers, so plan accordingly.



REMINDER: The next 4 days are official WORK DAYS. This in class time is extremely valuable and should be used effectively. It is your group responsibility to have your presentation ready for Friday. It counts towards a major chunk of your final grade.

Each group must also meet with the teacher during this class period.

Teacher: You will need to meet with each group today to approve their presentation proposal. Review the following:

- The type of presentation they are planning.
- Their ability to complete most of it in class given the present resources.
- The time constraints: 7-minute presentation plus 3-minute Q&A.
- The grading rubric for the project presentation (see below).

- Remember, EVERY team member must complete some aspect of this presentation. It can be divided up so that every person presents OR you can divide it up where some members complete the design work while others do the speaking. You must document your division of work on the proposal below.
