Welcome to Unit 3 of our Kindness in the Classroom curriculum. For the next 4-6 weeks we will be learning all about INCLUSIVENESS. Since this is still a fairly new concept for children this age, we will focus on the following topics:

| TOPIC | QUESTIONS WE WILL EXPLORE | HOW YOU CAN HELP AT HOME |

| You are Special | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• What makes each of us special?• How can we celebrate our uniqueness? | Talk with your child about what makes them and your family special? How can you embrace the things that are “different” from everyone else? |
| Teamwork | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Why do we need to work together?• How can teamwork help us when we are trying to finish something? | Brainstorm ways to work with others in the classroom, on the playground, and even at home. What does teamwork look like? |
| Inclusiveness | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• How can we include others, even if we do not know them?• Why is it important to give everyone a chance during games and other activities? | Discuss the connection between inclusiveness and kindness. Emphasize how including others requires kindness. We use our kind words and actions to make them feel welcome! |

Key activities we'll be doing:

- Play cooperative musical chairs!
- Practice inclusiveness with Lego designs!
- Practice including others!
- Use teamwork to win a game!
