This project incorporates social studies and the use of a compass to practice integrity. The task is to use your treasure map to find items that start with every letter in integrity, documenting where each item was found on their map.

## **Project Timeframe**


25-30 minutes

#### **Required Materials**

- ☐ Items beginning with each letter in INTEGRITY
- ☐ Blank Classroom Map for each group
- ☐ Clue Sheet for each group
- ☐ Compass for each group
- Pencils

#### Step 1:

Create a map of your classroom. Here is a standard template to get your juices flowing. You can also use this website to create one. http://classroom.4teachers.org



#### Step 2:

Provide a copy of your classroom map along with directional clues to help your students find the items. This will be very specific to your classroom.

**Example: Clue #1:** Starting from the teacher's desk, take 5 paces North, then 3 paces West. Look under the table. You found it! Draw a picture of what you saw and where you found it on the map provided.

Strategically place one item for each letter in **INTEGRITY** throughout the classroom. Here are some suggestions:

**I:** (they need to find 2): Ink in a pen, Book that starts with the letter I, inch on a ruler, igloo, iguana, ice cream

N: nest, nine, notebook, noodles, net, needle

T: (they need to find 2): Tree, Tomato, Test, Truck, Tail, Thermometer

E: egg, elephant, eel, envelope, eleven, eight

G: gorilla, grape, gears, gum, green

R: (they need to find 2): red, rubber band, rose, ruler, etc.

Y: Yoyo, Yellow, Yak, Yarn, Yacht
